

## SCHEC Minutes: May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2012, DeVry University

**Welcome and Introductions:** Ben Schoening called the meeting to order. A brief welcome was given by DeVry University which included a general overview of the various colleges. At DeVry . An introduction from all members present was given.

### **ED FAIRS:**

**Dan Weber** discussed the college fair calendar as well as asking that all members make sure they have the correct and most updated contact information on the membership list.

- There was also a mention of a CSCCU event to be held at University of La Verne in March, 2013

### **ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

**Mike Russell** from United States University offered a summer special from June 4<sup>th</sup>- July 29<sup>th</sup> general Ed classes to help students that may be impacted at State and local Junior Colleges. Tuition reduction voucher of \$200.00 classes are \$500 which includes Chula Vista, Cypress campuses and on-line.

**Trident University**—offering \$250 net semester credit. Full course \$1000 vs. \$1,200 no other fees. 2+2 initial focus on 2 year schools. Running 4 semester units' interim sessions.

**Argosy University** application for Doctor of Clinical Psychology being taken. (No master required) only APA credit in OC. \$1,107 per unit for the program.

**Brandman:** EDD program being offered starting in the fall. Still accepting application for Org and Leadership development program. Undergrad programs \$470 per unit. For military \$470 for the class.

**National University** info meeting being held May 19<sup>th</sup> at Costa Mesa campus. Offering summer school at a 50% reduction Nursing and General Ed. \$711 per course one month in June, July, August classes.

**Pepperdine University** \$1,099 per unit deadline is June 28<sup>th</sup> for the fall. Merit Scholarships offered.

**Cal State Dominguez Hills** no students Spring 2013. July 15<sup>th</sup> deadline for fall 2012.

**Biola University** open for fall 2012 applications.

**Webster University offering** undergraduate completion program still accepting applications. \$420 per unit.

**Hope International** is offering \$295 per credit for General Ed courses.

**Cal State Fullerton** June 1<sup>st</sup> transfer deadline. June 6<sup>th</sup> Final grade cards July 16<sup>th</sup> all final transcripts. Must sign up for transfer orientation half day , full day or on-line.

**Long Beach State Fall 2012** 98% admission. June 1 deadline Spring 13 closed to all students.

**Concordia University: accepting** applications for fall adult learner and day classes. Offering a summer term on line. General Ed classes for those who can't get classes at the local Community Colleges. Online General Ed \$245 per unit and Adult Degree program \$505 per unit.

**Trinity Law:** will be offering summer classes on Saturday starting 8/27. \$795 per unit.

**SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE:** Robert Walden and the scholarship committee gave an update on the applicants. For the 2010-11 recipients, funds were shifted to first two alternates since the two of those originally selected were no longer eligible. The 2011-12 recipients were also announced. Discussion of revisions of the Scholarship process: AB 540 students will become eligible, and other revisions are up for discussion. An ad-hoc committee will be formed to meet over the summer to discuss possible changes such as revising the scoring matrix, talk about exceptional students etc.
